What: Lincoln Bicentennial Benefit Run

When: Saturday, June 27, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.

Where: Southwest Indiana

Note: The Lincoln Bicentennial Benefit Run is a family-oriented driving tour that will follow the route that Abraham Lincoln took when he campaigned for Henry Clay for President in 1844. All two and four wheeled motorized vehicles are invited to participate. We will start at the Log Inn in Warrenton, Indiana with three stops enroute to Lincoln Pioneer Village in Rockport, Indiana. The first stop will be at Henager's Museum and National Veterans Memorial which has the largest Lincoln Bicentennial exhibit in the state of Indiana. The second stop will be Colonel William Jones' home in Gentryville, Indiana where Lincoln spent the night prior to visiting his mother's gravesite for the last time. The third stop is the Lincoln Boyhood Memorial where Lincoln's mother is buried. The final stop is Lincoln Pioneer Village in Rockport, Indiana where we will have special events and a picnic.
