**LINCOLN LOG**

NOVEMBER 30, 1843

In the Sangamon County Circuit Court, Lincoln represents his father-in-law Robert Todd, who is suing Nathaniel Ware. The parties agree on a hearing date and they agree to terms regarding the taking of depositions. Todd gave Ware three promissory notes and secured them with a mortgage. Todd and Ware agreed that Todd could pay the notes with State Bank of Illinois bank notes. Todd paid the money, but Ware refused to accept it because the bank notes had devalued considerably. Todd is suing Ware to accept the notes and to cancel the mortgage.
