Lincoln writes, “We the undersigners...Do find her to be four years old next Spring a bright bay 14 hands high—a small blaze and a snip in her face—right hind foot white—right fore foot with a white stripe down the hough and white hairs around the edge of the hough no brands perceivable black mane and tail appraised to 30 Dollars.”
