President Lincoln writes to his former law partner, Stephen Logan, of Springfield, Illinois, and he invites Logan to attend the November 19 dedication of the Gettysburg, Pennsylvania battlefield cemetery. Lincoln suggests that Logan and Logan's daughter, Sarah Lamon, travel together. Sarah is married to Lincoln's close friend, U.S. Marshal Ward Lamon, who will accompany Lincoln from Washington to Gettysburg. Lincoln writes, "It will be an interesting ceremony, and I shall be very glad to see you."
