Lincoln writes to Benjamin Lundy, of Magnolia, Illinois. In spite of Lincoln's recent loss to Stephen Douglas in the U.S. Senate race, Lundy predicted that many will support Lincoln if he chooses to run in 1860 for "President, Vice President or Governor." Lincoln writes, "It affords me great pleasure to learn that our friends are nowhere dispirited...Douglas managed to be supported both as the best instrument to break down, and to uphold the slave power. No ingenuity can keep this deception...up a great while."
