In the Sangamon County Circuit Court case of *People v. Anderson & Anderson*, Lincoln and the other attorneys argue the case before a jury. On May 15, witnesses discovered George Anderson's body lying in his Monroe Street backyard. Anderson suffered a severe blow to the head. The state's attorney indicted Anderson's wife, Jane and his nephew, Theodore Anderson, for murder. Lincoln, Stephen Logan, and John Rosette represent Theodore Anderson.
