Lincoln is in Clinton, Illinois, where a jury hears the arguments in the De Witt County Circuit Court case of *Campbell v. Cole & Wall*. The jury considers a verdict. Nelson Campbell asserts that the firm of Cole & Wall did not pay him for completing the wood work on ditching machines that Cole & Wall built. Lincoln represents John Cole and A Little One Wall, who claim that they paid Campbell after arbitrators awarded him \$121.50. Campbell seeks \$800 in damages.
